#### **Secretarial Update:**

# **Directors' Updates:**

#### **Chorus:**

#### Band:

- The band director was not in attendance and will provide updates at a future meeting.

- The Tri-M induction ceremony occurred.
- Disney 2023 planning will be happening soon.
- A tentative date of May 20 was mentioned for Great East; Stephanie will check with Mr. Barth about Fowler's transportation budget for music students.

#### Wind Ensemble/Jazz Bands:

- The director was not in attendance. A bid was made in her absence for an bass pickup for use by MHS Band and Jazz Band. Three options were considered.
- Jazz Cafe is scheduled for March 25.

## **Webmaster Update:**

- The private instructors' list and lists of sponsors are being updated.
- Recent recordings of performances may be put on the website, depending on audio quality.
- Tri-M induction photos may be added to the photo gallery.

## **Treasurer Update:**

- The Annual Appeal's total numbers are in: \$12,506.09 was raised, with about \$377 in expenses. The net amount (about \$11,800) will be split between the schools.
- Fowler's working balance is \$19,116.81, and MHS's working balance is \$2,926.
- The question was raised of whether to combine the school accounts, and this may be an issue the MMA considers over the summer.

## **MHS Chair Updates:**

- MMA will make a decision about the details of a scholarship in Ronan Jeannotte's name, perhaps in partnership with MEA, at a later date.

- Recruiting for open leadership positions continues, and Rachel Leeuwis and Cheryl Lucas have expressed interest for next year as MHS co-chairs.
