**MHS Chair updates:**

- At-large members were welcomed to the meeting; they will be representing a grade. MMA is in particular need of more Fowler parent participation.
- The March meeting minutes were voted on and can be posted.
- Three officer terms are ending this June. Pam put her name in for co-chair for MHS, and Sarah will run for secretary again.
- Scholarship applications are due April 25; the first round will be decided by May 5, and the committee will review for the second round in mid-May.
- The Senior Banquet Committee will hold their first meeting and are waiting for the Sanctuary contract and final negotiations for sound management.
- Pam suggested having eighth graders potentially present their instruments to younger students during Fowler's Fine Arts Night.

**Website updates:**

- The cost of hosting has gone up but now includes domain registration.

**Treasury updates:**

- MMA has about \$56,000 in its bank accounts, plus \$555 set aside in the Tri-M account. Based on fundraising this year so far, MMA is on track to spend about \$2,000 more than we've brought in.

**Band Director updates:**

- The Pyramid Concert, featuring musicians across all three schools, was well received and will likely be repeated in future years.
- The Tri-M induction ceremony included a lot of student participation.
- The Fine Arts Night may include an "instrument petting zoo."
- Junior Districts is coming up and will not require MMA support.

- A request was made to repair two bassoons, but this does not need to be voted on as MMA has budgeted for instrument repairs.
- Clinicians before Six Flags for Fowler students will likely cost less than \$300.
- A recent request was made for moving a donated upright piano to Fowler, at \$335.

**DC trip updates:**

- Final details are being worked out, including late payments and health forms, along with reminders about uniform check dates and baggage dropoff.

**Jazz Band Director updates:**

- Before the meeting, the director proposed a West African drumming workshop for the jazz bands, and any other music students who would like to join. The details and date are still in flux, with an expectation that it will cost \$1,000.

**In-meeting votes:**

A motion was made to approve using GoDaddy for the hosting and domain registration of MMA's website, for \$100 per year.

**Final vote:** 9/9

**Motion carried:** Yes

**Post-meeting online votes:**

A motion was made to pay \$335 to Paiz Movers to move a donated piano to Fowler School.

**Final vote:** 5/7

**Motion carried:** Yes
